The World Utilities Congress 2025 concluded with resounding success, reaffirming its role as the premier global platform for the power and water utilities sector. Taking place at the ADNEC Centre Abu Dhabi from 27–29 May 2025, the event united **183 international exhibitors**, **443 expert speakers**, **and 19,764 industry professionals** from around the world.

The congress was inaugurated with an opening ceremony, held in the presence of VIPs, dignitaries and global CEOs. During the session, keynotes were delivered by **H.E. Suhail Mohamed Al Mazrouei**, Minister of Energy & Infrastructure, United Arab Emirates; **H.E. Dr. Abdullah Humaid Saif Al Jarwan**, Chairman, Abu Dhabi Department of Energy; **Jasim Thabet**, Group CEO and MD, Abu Dhabi National Energy Company (TAQA).

With **111 conference sessions**, vital MOUs signed and exclusive product launches, the event showcased groundbreaking innovations and fostered valuable connections, leaving a lasting impact on the future of the global utilities sector.

2025 also saw the launch of **FUEL (Future Utilities and Energy Leaders)** welcoming university students, young innovators and fresh graduates, to connect with, and learn from global leaders.

The World Utilities Congress brought together **183 international and regional exhibitors,** each showcasing the latest innovations across key sectors such as power generation, transmission and distribution, energy services, water and mobility.
